## 1 Provider Information

- Start date
- Updated NPI (current practice)
- Valid government ID (driver's license or passport)
- Visa (if applicable)
- Proof of name change (if applicable)

## 2 Licenses & Certifications

- Current & prior state medical licenses
- Board certification certificates (or status documents)
- ATLS, BLS, ACLS, PALS, etc. certifications

## 3 Education & Work History

- Education certificates/diplomas
- Complete educational history (undergrad & professional)
- Employment history, including explanations for gaps >3 months
- Current CV (in MM/DD/YYYY format)

## 4 Insurance & References

Malpractice insurance certificate

Peer references with current contact information

## 5 Online Accounts & Access

CAQH login credentials username + password sent separately)

Medicare I&A account access approval

## 6 Disclosure & Compliance

Completed disclosure questions

Archived prior employment & work locations
